
We have rescheduled the dates of our General Membership and Executive Committee meetings for the rest of the year so please review the new schedule and mark you calendars accordingly.

## The Agrimensores are coming to the meeting!!




The University of Akron Surveying Students (Agrimensores)

The April General Membership meeting was at Maria's Restaurant in Lakewood. There were 26 members in attendance. Craig Strong of the Cuyahoga County Engineer's Office gave a very interesting presentation on the construction of the Veteran's Memorial Bridge.

Some of the topics discussed during the meeting were as follows:

- ODOT is looking for PLSO support in its proposal to convert Ohio from a 2
   Zone State Plane projection into a 1 Zone State Plane projection.
- PLSO purchased a new copy machine for \$8400 for the state office.
- The Michigan Museum of Surveying is still looking for an Ohio Professional Surveyor for their board.
- The State of West Virginia recently passed legislation requiring a four-year degree and continuing education for Professional Surveyors.
- Ohio State University announced that they would no longer be accepting students for their Surveying program.
- The May/June State newsletter will have an article about the Statute of Limitations on surveys.
- PLSO donated a survey instrument to the Michigan Museum of Surveying and is looking for donations to cover the cost of the instrument.


