
## MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

The May General Membership meeting was held May 16, 2002 at Quinn's Restaurant in Solon. There were 20 members in attendance. Mike & Ann Besch and Daniel Engle of the University of Akron gave a presentation on the ancient Roman survey competition that took place at the ACSM/FIG conference in Washington D.C. in April.

Some of the topics discussed during the meeting were as follows:

- Neil Hetrick handed out copies of the State Line Newsletter with upcoming dates for work in
- HB 337 was passed by the legislature and becomes effective August 7, 2002. This bill modernizes and streamlines the registration act.
- The proposed location for the monument of the center of population in Ohio has been relocated to the courthouse in Mount Gilead. ODOT's proposed 1-zone state plane projection system would be supplemental and would not affect the current 2-zone system.
- The updated State PLSO website is online at www.ohiosurveyor.org.
- The May/June State newsletter will have an article about the Statute of Limitations on surveys. The State Board will be re-circulating Bulletin 95-4 to all Ohio title insurance companies regarding title insurance companies insuring over the standard survey exception without the benefit of a survey.
- John Bischof reported that he has begun preparations for changing the curriculum of the PLSO survey class. The ACSM Certified Survey Technician test would be the final for the survey class and it would be proctored by ACSM. He is also looking for instructors for the fall survey class.
- John G. Hoy reported that he would send out flyers this summer for the golf outing and the Indians
