Kentucky Board of Licensure Discontinues 'State-Specific' Exam for Surveying

Excerpt from The Board of Licensure Report — October 2018

The following is taken from the referenced publication; "At the October 12, 2018 meeting, the Board of Licensure voted to discontinue the two-hour State Specific Exam for land surveying license candidates. In lieu of the exam, surveyor license applicants will receive printed information regarding the statutes and regulations which govern the practice of land surveying in Kentucky." The article also noted that the Principles and Practice of Surveying exam is now computer-based. Further rationale that has been reported for this action includes: the removal of an additional layer of regulatory barrier in an effort to encourage licensure, and the Board's current professional examination administration statutory limitation wording.
