

But there has to be more. The Chapters, and any



Friday July 12, 2013

Call to order 6:06 PM

- -21 Officers and Delegates present, Quorum Established.
- Review and passage of May meeting minutes.
- Treasurer's Report: Reviewed and accepted subject to the Finance Committee's review, as per the Charter guidelines.
- New Members: Motion passed to accept 4 professional re-instatement members, 2 student members, 1 retired member and 3 life members.

State Board of Registration: The Board continues to review the mineral rights issue. The house is on summer break. No activity on computer based testing. Probable effective date sometime in early 2014.

Ohio Surveying News deadline is July 1st. Notably its annual budget is down from\$22,000 to \$10,000 due to computer based technology and on-line publishing.

N.S.P.S. Governor:

- Vote passed to send e-ballots for the constitution changes and the N.S.P.S. membership issue on August 1st. Members will be given 30 days to review and voting deadline will be August 31st.
- –11 states have already signed the M.O.U. with N.S.P.S.
- N.S.P.S. Governor Bob Akins has an 18 page Power-Point presentation available for review as a PDF on the web-site. He well Tele-conference with any group wishing to review the presentation and issues.
- In a separate vote the support of the N.S.P.S. membership issue was passed. 19 yeas, 3 nays.
- Trig Star had a very active spring and seven chapters sponsored the test at eight Ohio high schools.

Program:

- Annual Conferences: 2014 committee met at the Kalahari Resort and Conference Center to continue the final planning of the Annual Conference. Programming is moving forward. We are on schedule.
- The Workshop Program has done very well with its statewide efforts and realized double the anticipated income.

Scholarship: Out of six applications 5 scholarship awards were made. 3 for \$2000 each at University of Akron. 2 for \$1000 each at Ohio State university.

Adjourned at 8:30 PM.
